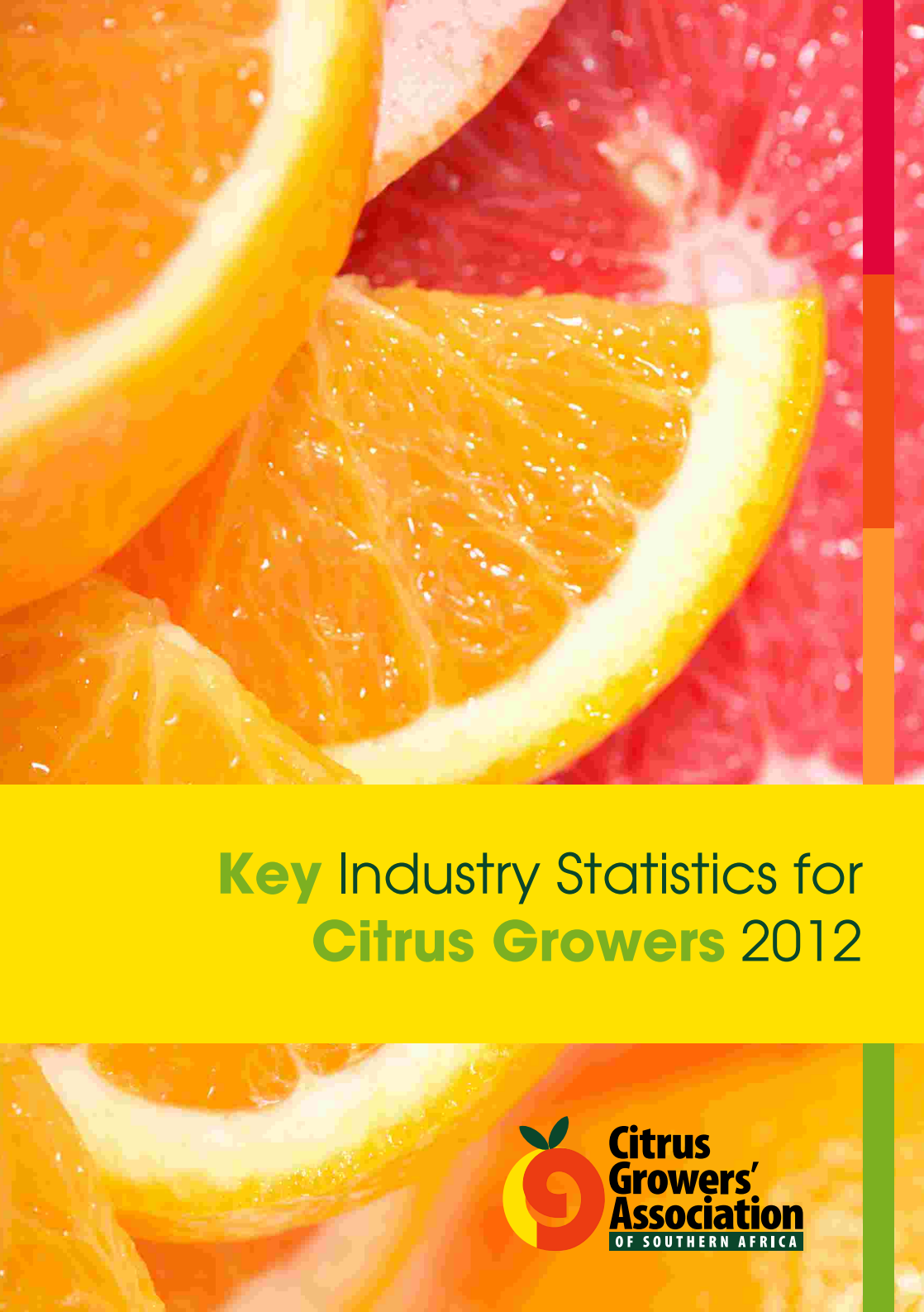

The Citrus Growers' Association relies on growers to submit tree census information each year before going to press. Readers should bear in mind that this booklet represents data for the 2011 export season.

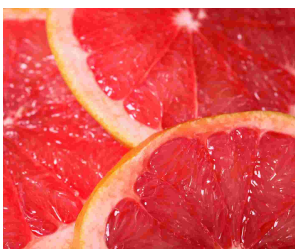

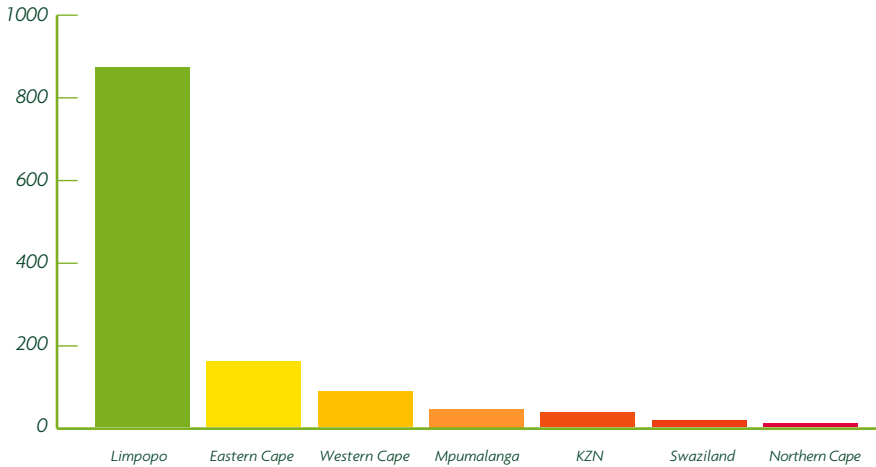

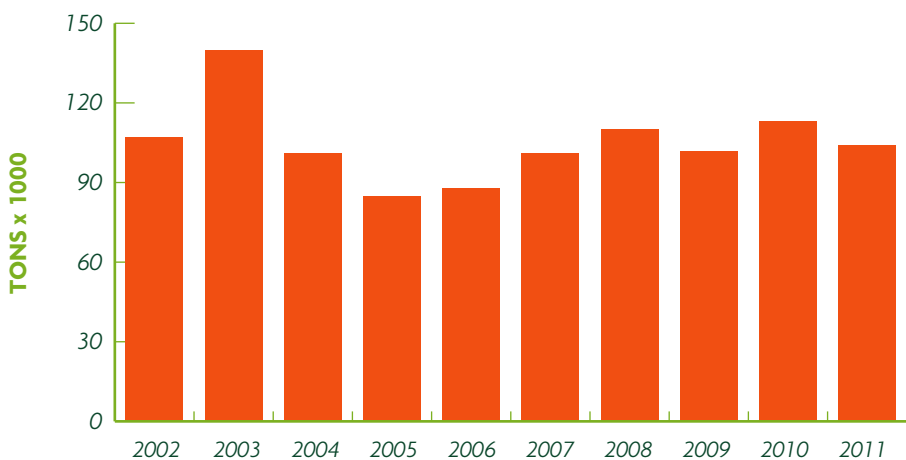

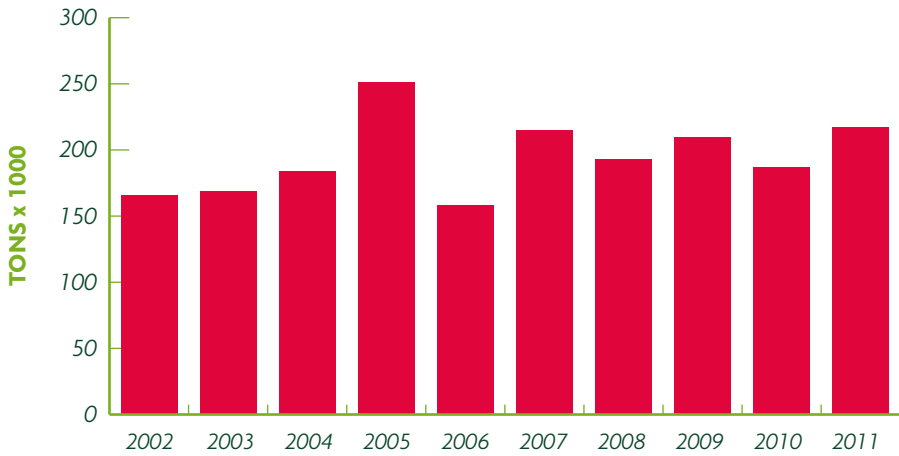

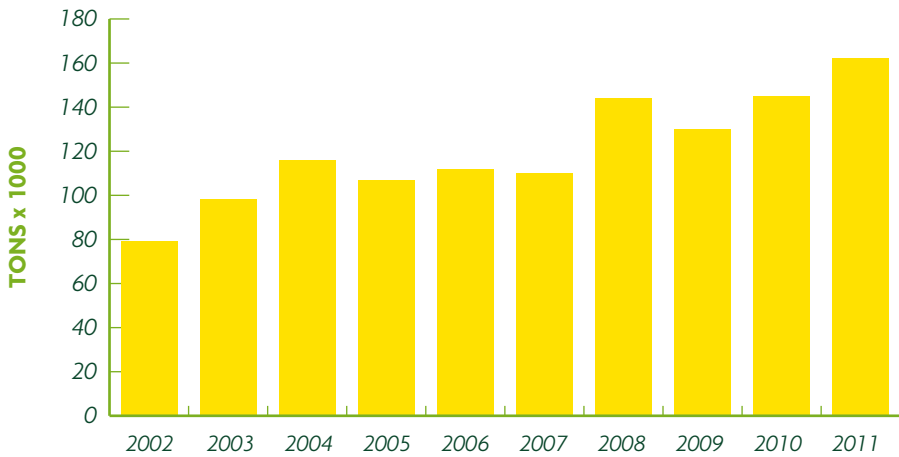

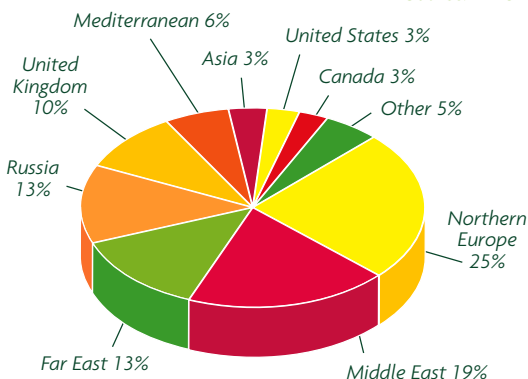
EXPORT PRODUCTS 2011

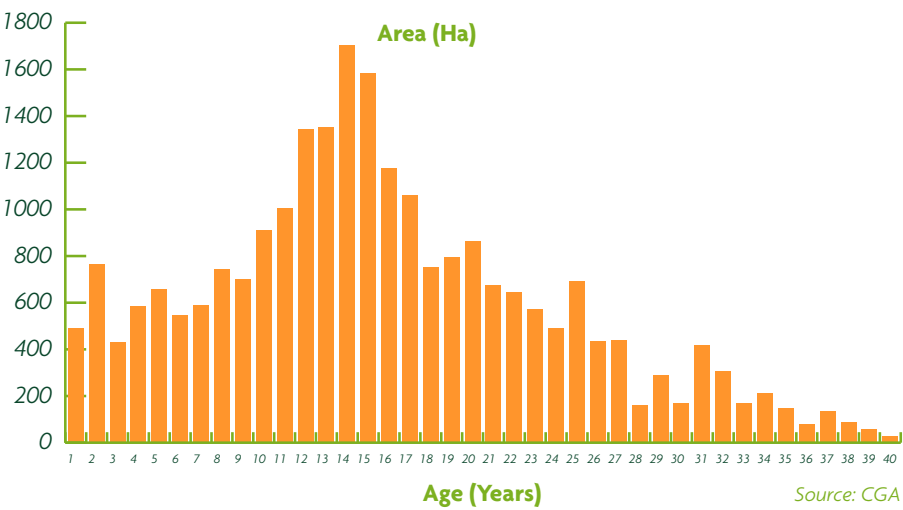


Age Class Distribution

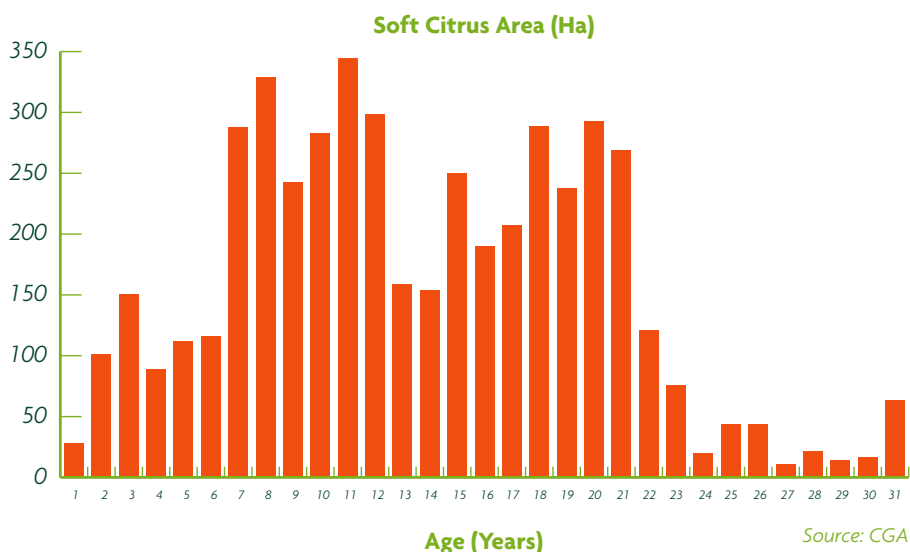

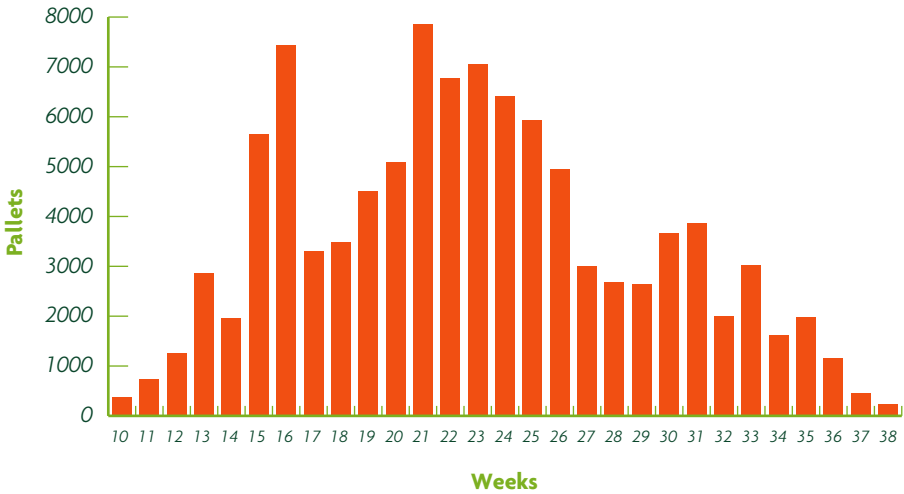

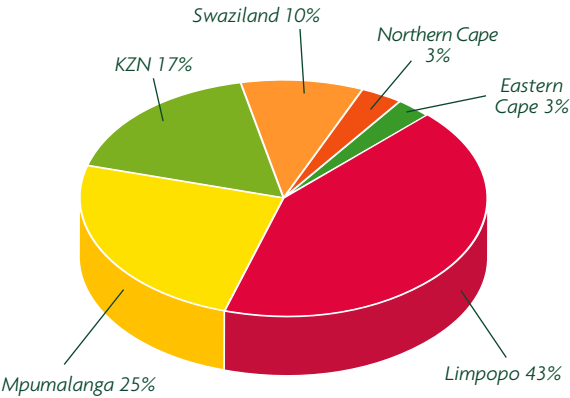

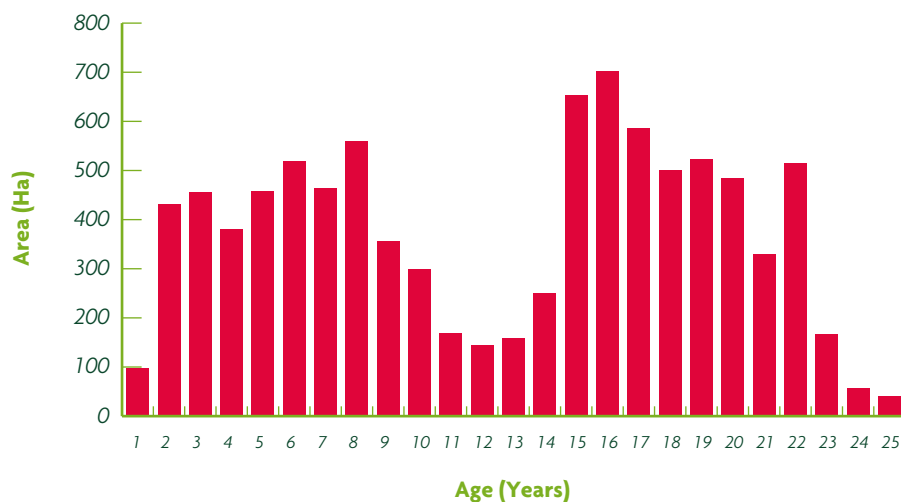

Age Distribution Grapefruit



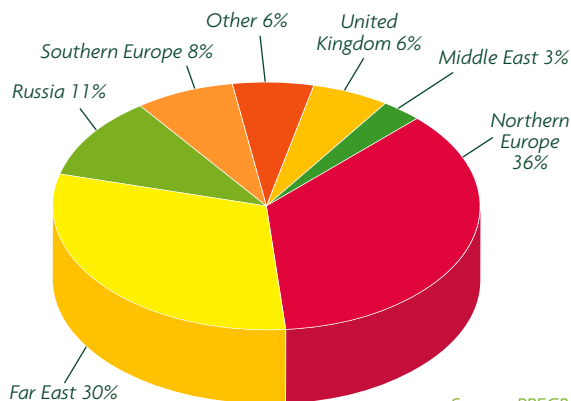

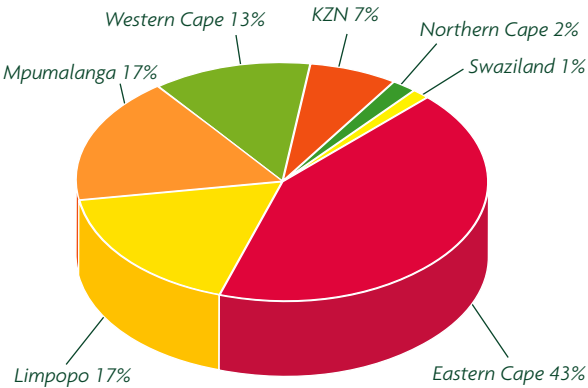

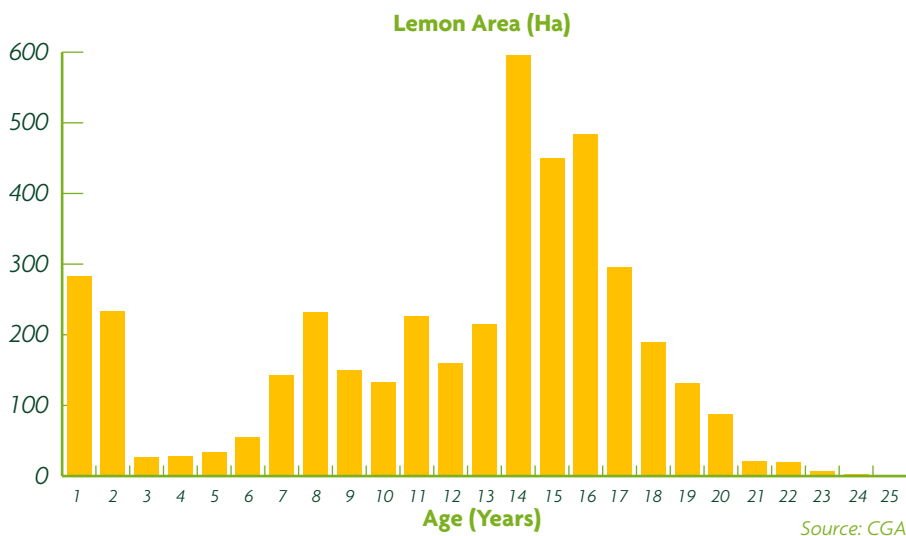

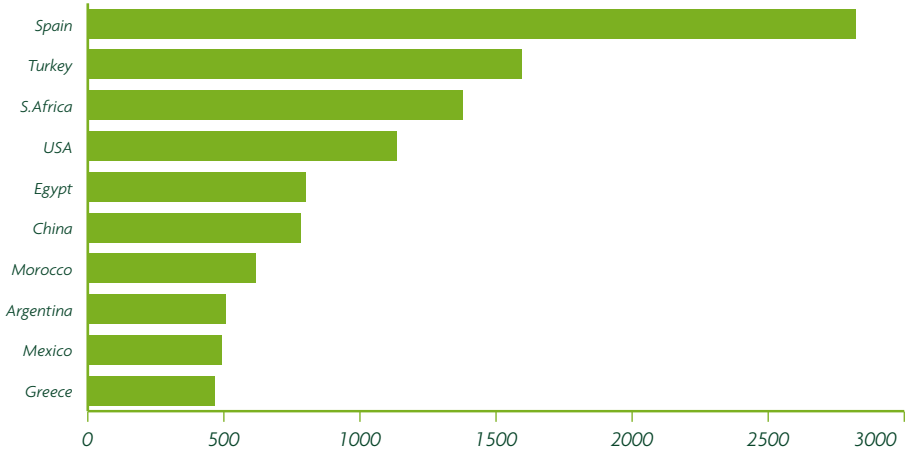

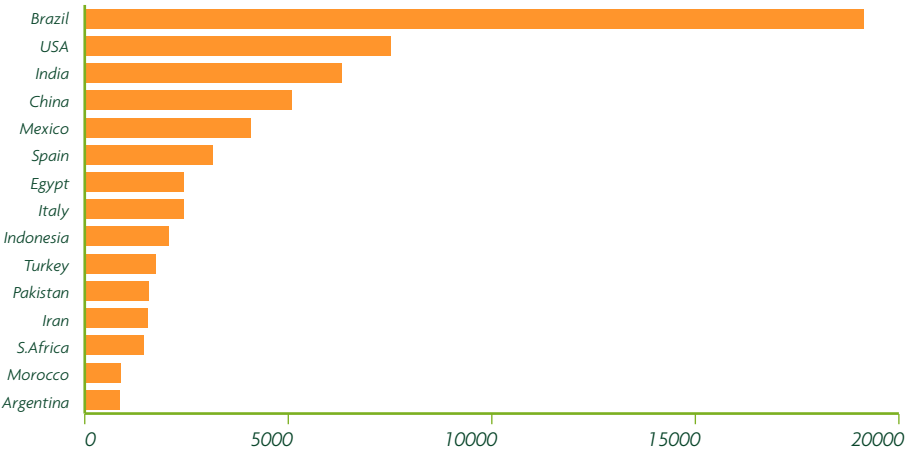

WORLD FRESH CITRUS EXPORTS (thousand tons)



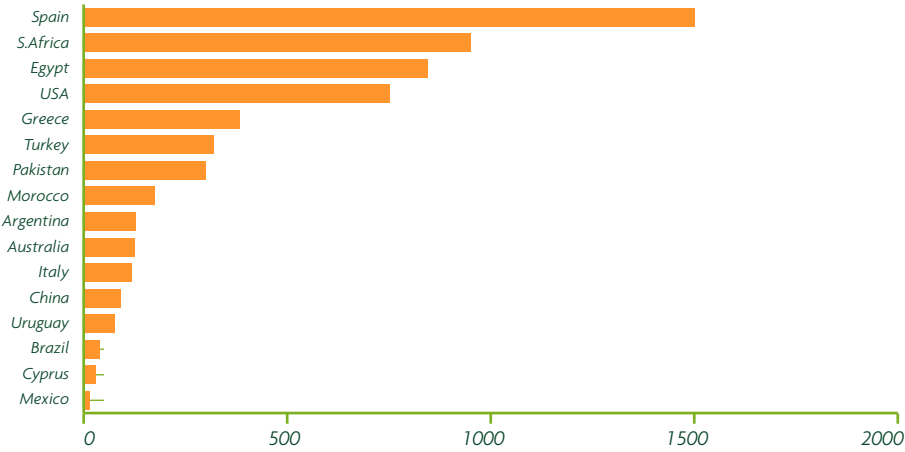

WORLD ORANGE PRODUCTION 2010/11 (thousand tons)



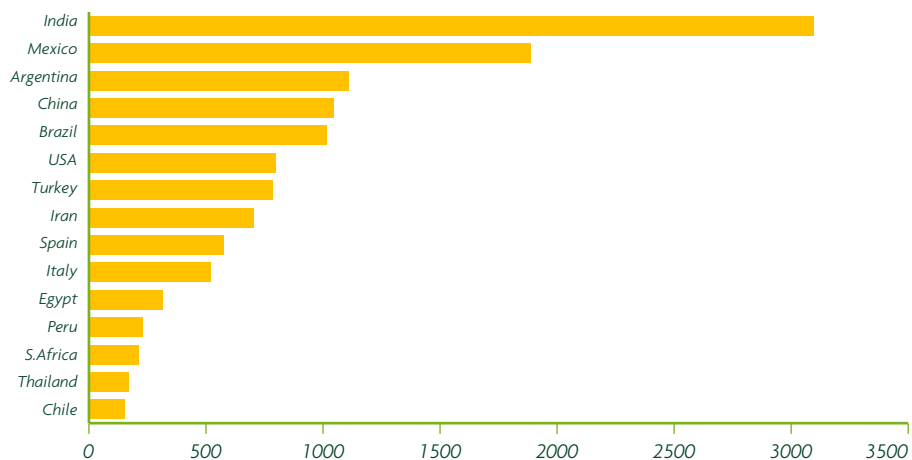

WORLD ORANGE EXPORTS 2010/11 (thousand tons)



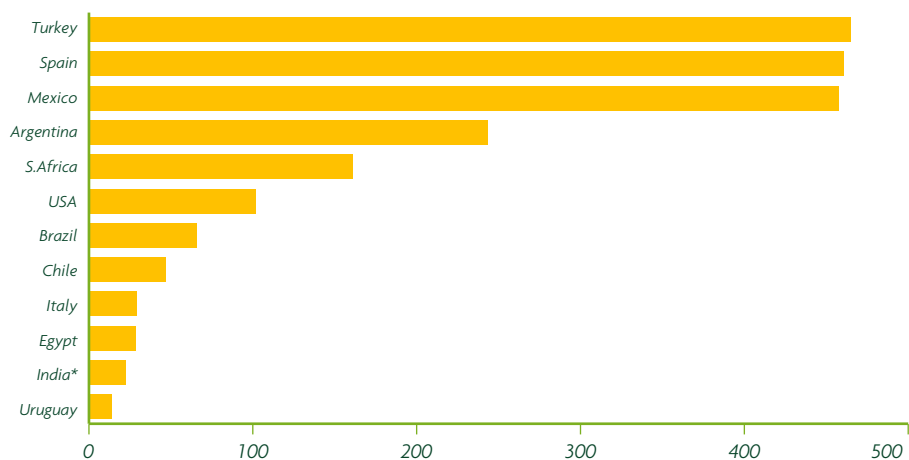

WORLD LEMON PRODUCTION 2010/11 (thousand tons)



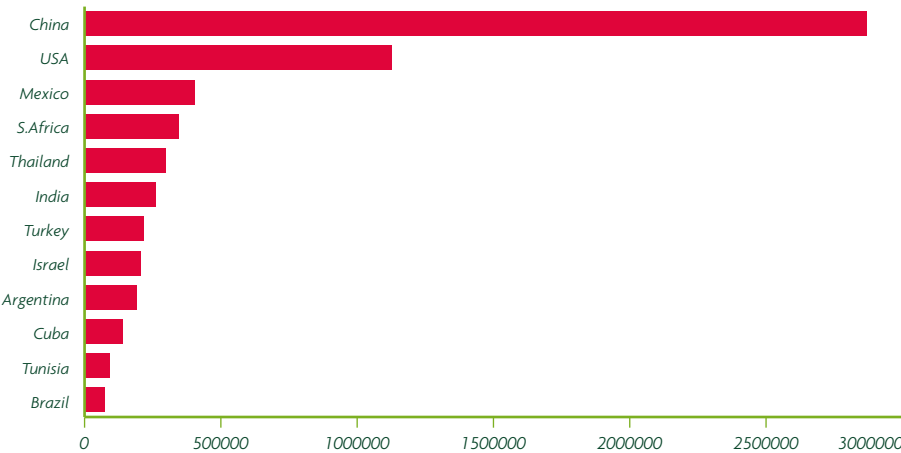

WORLD LEMON EXPORTS 2010/11 (thousand tons)



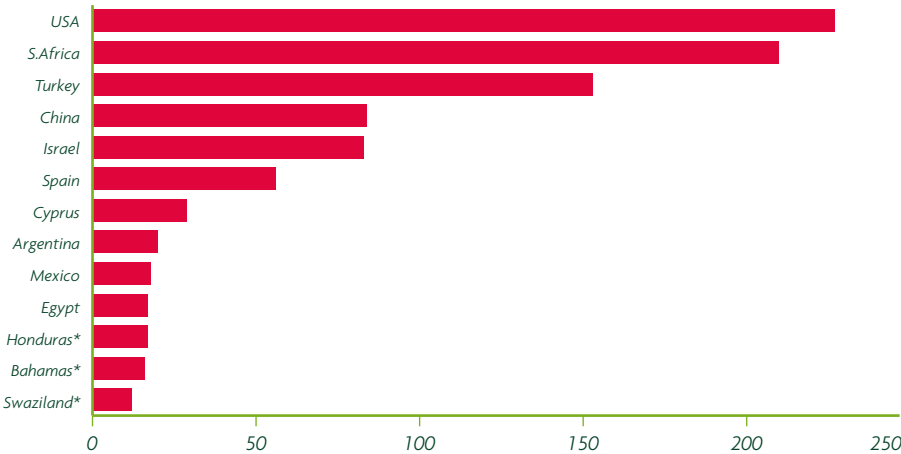

WORLD GRAPEFRUIT PRODUCTION 2010/11 (thousand tons)



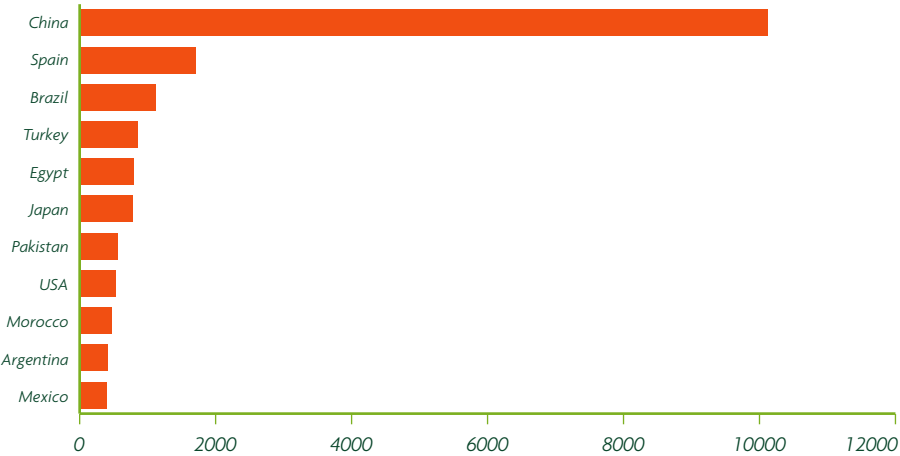

WORLD GRAPEFRUIT EXPORTS 2010/11 (thousand tons)



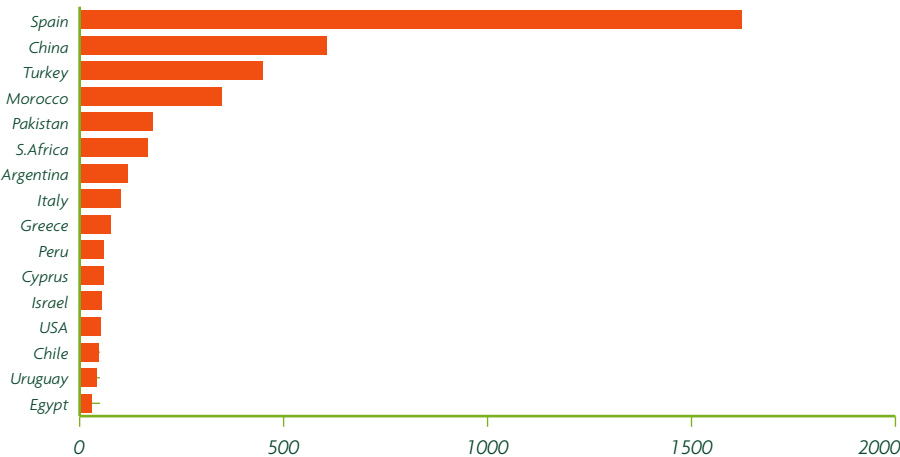

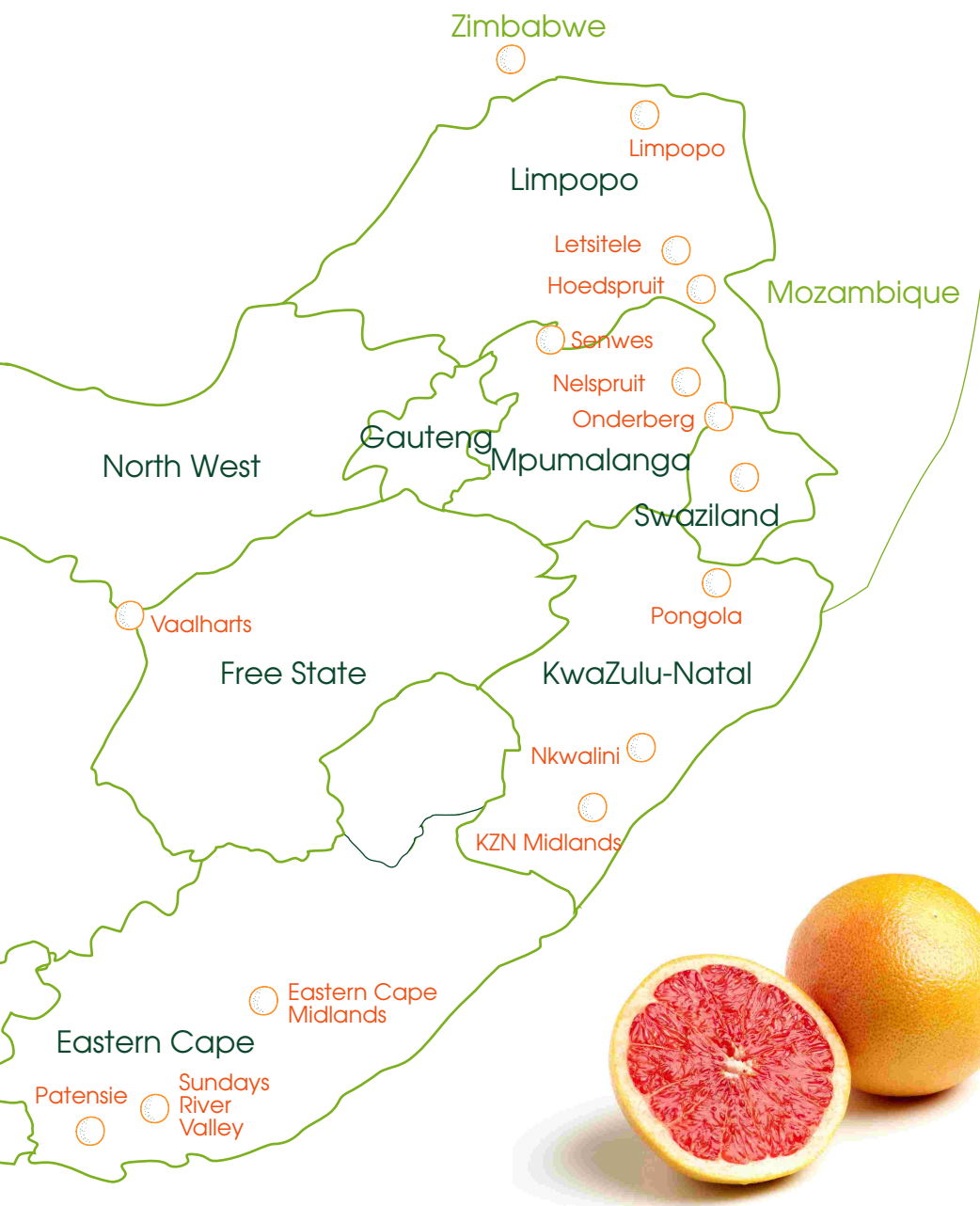
