



Issue Resolution in the EU Market

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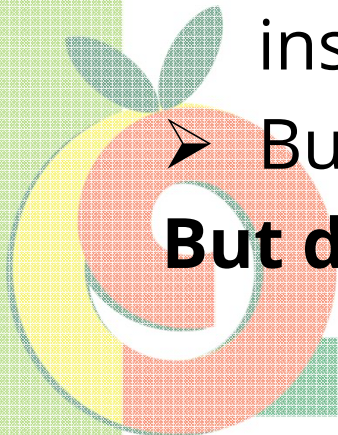
2014 in retrospect

Achievements:

- Shaped EU regulation to:
 - Avoid market closure
 - SA induced solution and compromise [SA control]
 - Avoid automatic 5-strike clause
 - Secure reasonable EU sampling and testing requirements
 - Secure limitation of Ethapon testing to Valencia's
- Minimised late season interceptions through pre-inspections in Rotterdam [30 to 5]
- Built trust with technical visits to NL, DE and FR

But don't forget Poudelet's gift: 9 interceptions

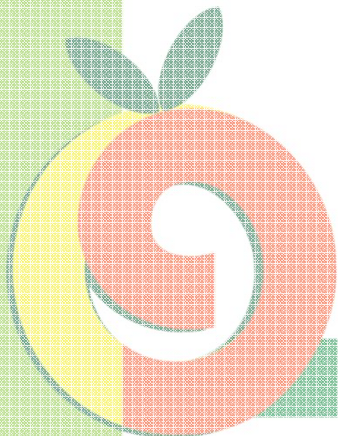

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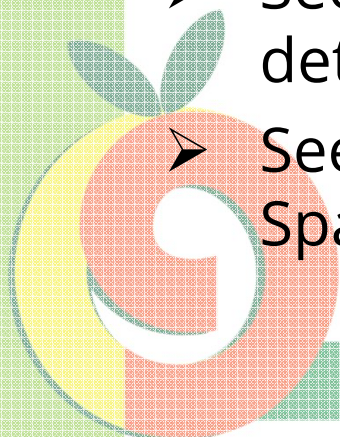
2015 prospects

Regulation:

- No change to EC Decision 2014/422 on the table, season is open
- Ethapon testing applies to all Valencia's from day 1
- Measures reviewed after 5 strikes if EC considers as result of "failing monitoring and certification procedures"

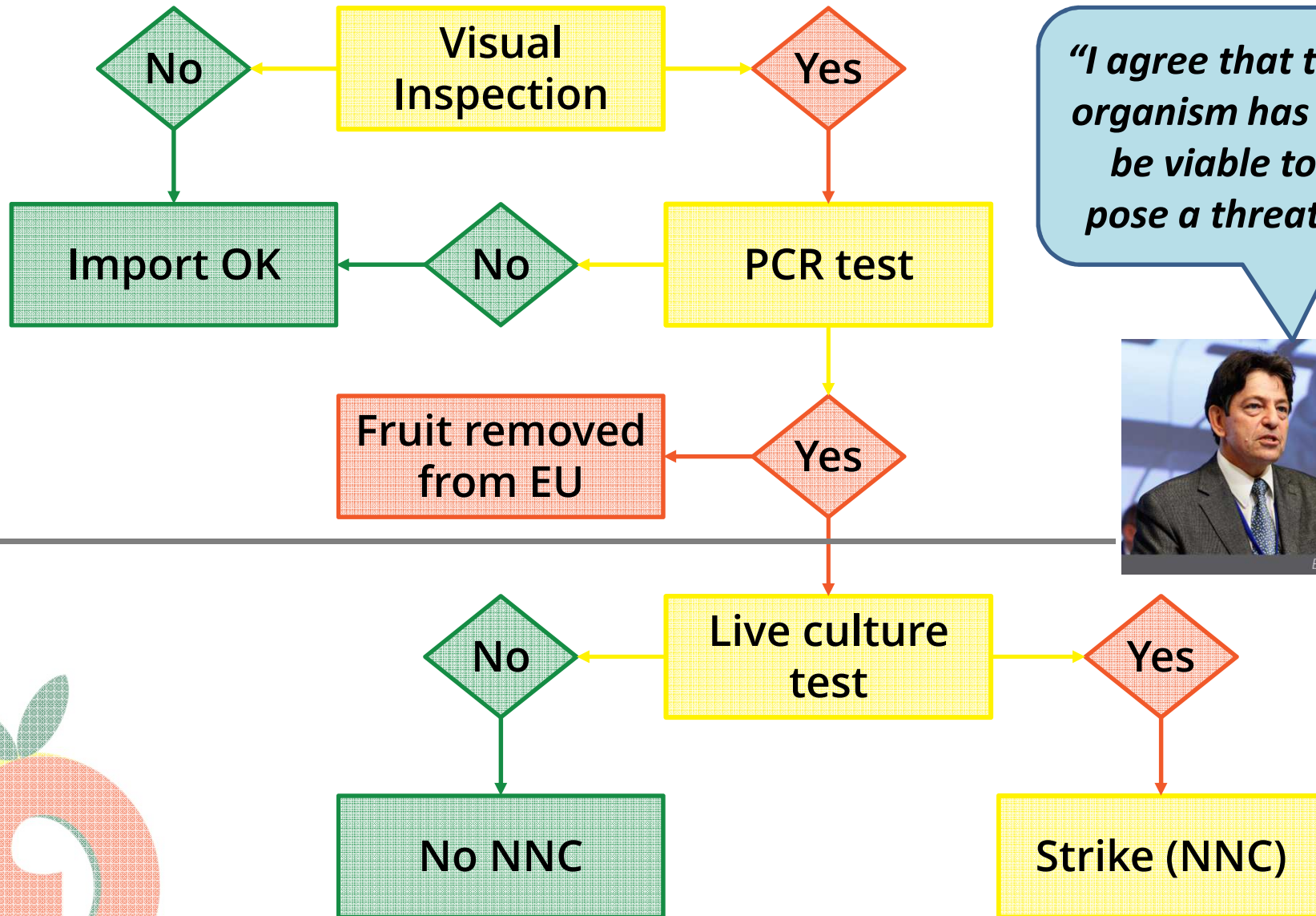
Sampling and testing:

- Seeking avoidance of Spanish over-zealousness, as in 2014 (systematic testing of asymptomatic fruits)
- Seeking recognition of live culture testing necessity to determine organism viability, i.e. conditions for strike
- Seeking technical visits to testing facilities in Italy and Spain



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Our current battle



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Next steps

- DAFF request re. viability testing for strike to EC [included in 2014/422/EU] – issue not identification but risk mitigation
- Continue lobbying Member States [national authority]
- EU SCPH meeting end March
 - No additional measures on the table
 - FVO to report informally
 - Viability testing discussion, but no decision
- Specialist visit - outstanding MS - Spain, Italy, France, etc
- EFSA scientific debate – dead-end, push for IPPC resolution
- Monitor FCM developments [2 yr. window regionalisation?]
