Southern African citrus export volumes highest ever – CGA

Southern African citrus export volumes are currently at their highest levels ever according to the Citrus Growers' Association (CGA).

“With volumes packed closing in on 1.8 million tons and only a few weeks of packing left, the final packed figure will not be far off the season’s opening estimate of 122.7 million cartons,” said CGA CEO Justin Chadwick.

Additionally, CGA recorded a larger volume of grapefruit exported in 2017 in comparison with the previous year. The European Union – including the UK – was the largest importer with 5.5 million cartons, representing a market share of 41%.

Asia imported 3.1 million cartons compared to 2.4 million in 2016 and increased its market share from 20 to 23%.

While South East Asia imports increased from 1.6 million to 1.8 million cartons, its market share dropped by 1% and Russia increased its market share by the same amount.
