



Zimbabwean exporters welcome increased shipments to China

A first shipment of Zimbabwean citrus is set to depart for the Asian country in July. In conjunction with this event, Zimbabwean businesses have welcomed the export of more local products to China.

Denford Mutashu, president of the Confederation of Zimbabwe Retailers, has stated that an increase in Zimbabwean products entering the vast Chinese market creates an even playing field in bilateral trade between the two countries.

"Zimbabwe is poised to benefit and especially expand the number of products that we are exporting to China," Mutashu said.

China is one of Zimbabwe's top export destinations, ranking as the third-largest importer of Zimbabwean goods in 2022, according to the country's trade promotion body ZimTrade.
