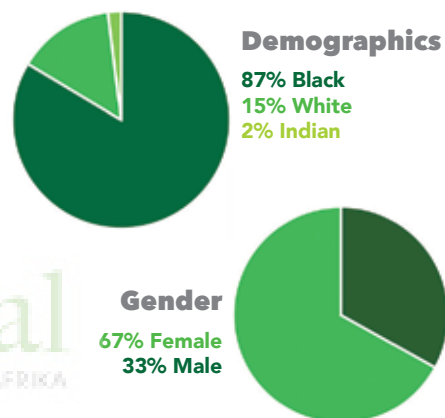
A fresh crop of students
