AGRO ENERGY FUND AND AVO SOLAR

The Agro Energy Fund is a blended finance scheme established to help agri-businesses acquire alternative energy assets to reduce their overall energy costs and carbon footprint. It focusses on all energy-intensive activities, including irrigation and on-farm cooling facilities. It is open to both primary and secondary agri-businesses. Thus far, a small amount of the original R1.2 billion program has been taken up, and if uptake appetite is there, the fund can justify expanding the programme to R2.5 billion. The relationship between grant and loan is as follows:

Large and Mega-scale

30% grant funding to be matched with a 70% loan portion, grant capped at the maximum of R1.5 million.

Medium-scale

50% grant to be matched with a 50% loan portion, grant capped at the maximum of R1 million.

Small-scale

70% grant portion to be matched with a 30% loan, grant funding capped at the maximum of R500k.
