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AgriSETA Discretionary Grants application window

Application period | 01 August 2022 – 15 September 2022 at 24h00

Agriculture Sector Education Authority (AgriSETA) invites eligible stakeholders within the agricultural sector to apply for Discretionary Grant funding. The Discretionary Grant is intended to meet the AgriSETA skills needs as set out in the Sector Skills Plan (SSP), Strategic Plan, priorities in the National Skills Development Plan, Economic Reconstruction and Recovery Plan (ERRP), as well as the Master Plans in Agriculture. In addition, the allocation of discretionary grant funds intends to improve the supply of qualified and competent workers for Hard-to-Fill Vacancies.

Please note: Due to the high volume of applications received by AgriSETA in the past, stakeholders are advised to limit applications to projects in line with the Sectorial Priority Occupations and Intervention list for 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 programmes, as per the National Skills Development Plan (NSDP).

AgriSETA invites all levy and non-levy paying Employers, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO's), Community-Based Organisations (CBO's), Non-Profit Organisations (NPO's), Cooperatives, TVET Colleges, Accredited Training Providers, Agricultural Colleges, Universities, Universities of Technology, SMME's, Community Education and Training Colleges (CET's), Agricultural Trade Unions / Federations, Companies, Land Reform beneficiaries, and small BEE companies to forward applications for the respective Learning Programmes.

The application window is open from 1 August 2022 until 15 September 2022 at 24h00. Please note that there is only one application window this year as opposed to previous years, where there have been two application windows.
