Citrus Short Courses

Citrus Academy short courses are aimed at providing a short, sharp insight into essential components of the citrus production system. Short courses will give you a good induction into the subject matter, help you to understand how that component fits into the wider production system, and they are a good starting point if you would like to enter a career in that aspect of the system.

The next short course to be held is Citrus Production, which will take place in the Sundays River Valley on 5-7th October 2022. The Citrus Production short course focuses on all the aspects of citrus production, including the history of the industry, the roles of industry organisations, citrus production practices and the citrus export value chain.
